### 1. CPD (Continuing Professional Development)

Total Spend: **£4,800**

We are committed to the continuous professional development of our staff to ensure high-quality PE teaching and inclusive sporting provision across the school.

- **External training courses – £800**
- Staff attended external PE-focused training sessions to deepen subject knowledge and ensure best practice across the school.
- **Internal learning and development – £4,000**
- We delivered in-house training and development for staff, allowing collaborative planning and upskilling with a focus on inclusive PE and active learning across the curriculum.

### 2. Internal Activities

Total Spend: **£12,450**

This section represents targeted spending to enhance day-to-day provision for pupils, enriching both the curriculum and extracurricular offer.

- **Extra-curricular opportunities – £1,400**
- Clubs including dance, football, gymnastics, and other physical activities were offered throughout the year, improving children's access to sport beyond the classroom.
- **Internal sports competitions – £150**
- Intra-school events were delivered to build confidence and foster healthy competition within the school community.
- **Top-up swimming lessons/aquatic opportunities – £4,250**
- Pupils across the school who had not yet met national swimming standards were given extra swimming sessions, promoting safety, confidence, and skill development.

- **Active travel – £4,200**
- Our school promoted opportunities for children to become more physically active during the school day, both on the playground and the field.
- **PE equipment and resources – £2,250**
- A substantial investment in new and replacement PE equipment ensured inclusive and engaging provision across all year groups.
- **Educational platforms and resources – £200**
- We subscribed to PE-related digital tools that support lesson planning and enhance children’s physical literacy through interactive content.

No funds were used on internal membership fees this year.

### 3. External Activities

Total Spend: **£2,800**

We prioritised pupil engagement in wider community sport by accessing external expertise and local competition networks.

- **School Games Organiser Network – £250**
- Participation in the School Games enabled pupils to attend district-wide sports festivals and competitions in a structured, supportive environment.
- **Other inter-school competitions – £150**
- Children represented the school in additional sporting fixtures, developing teamwork, determination, and school spirit.
- **External coaching staff – £2,400**
- Specialist coaches were employed to enhance lesson delivery, develop specific skills in sports such as football and cricket, and enrich after-school club provision.
