Teaching //



There will be some whole-class teaching, followed by small-group activities where we will work with children on a focused task. This approach allows us to support each child at their level and help everyone make progress.

Our aim is for every child to experience success while also being appropriately challenged.

Reading //

Children will bring home books matched to their RWI reading level. Once they finish the phonics programme, they will move on to Accelerated Reader, where they can choose books and complete quizzes. We also encourage regular reading at home and welcome families to borrow books from our library.



Play //



Play is still an important part of Hedgehogs but it becomes more purposeful and structured. Children enjoy carousel activities, brain breaks and movement throughout the day, while spending more time developing the knowledge and skills needed for the Key Stage 1 curriculum.

Expectations //

One Voice: I will wait for others to finish talking before I speak.

Listening Ears: I will listen carefully and follow instructions.

Raised Hand: I will put my hand up to share an idea or ask a question.

Caring Heart: I will be kind and treat others with respect.
